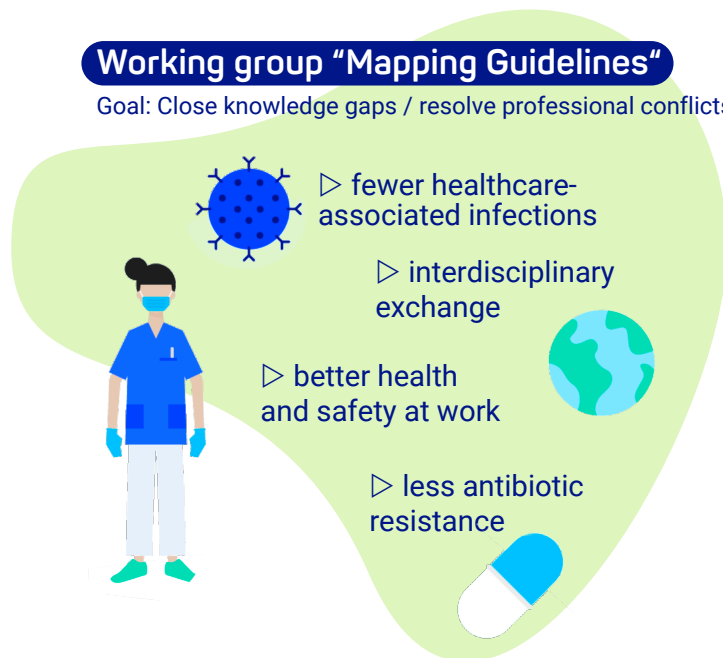


Commitment from HARTMANN and BODE

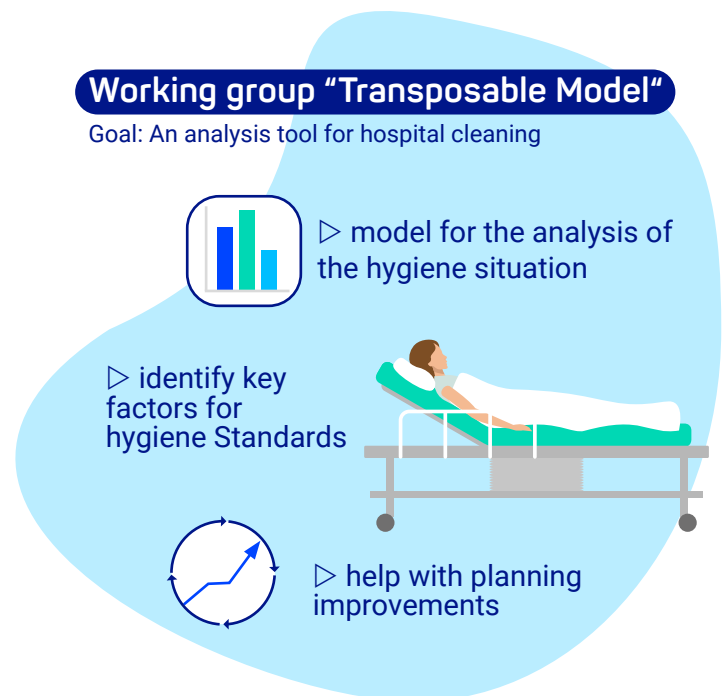
